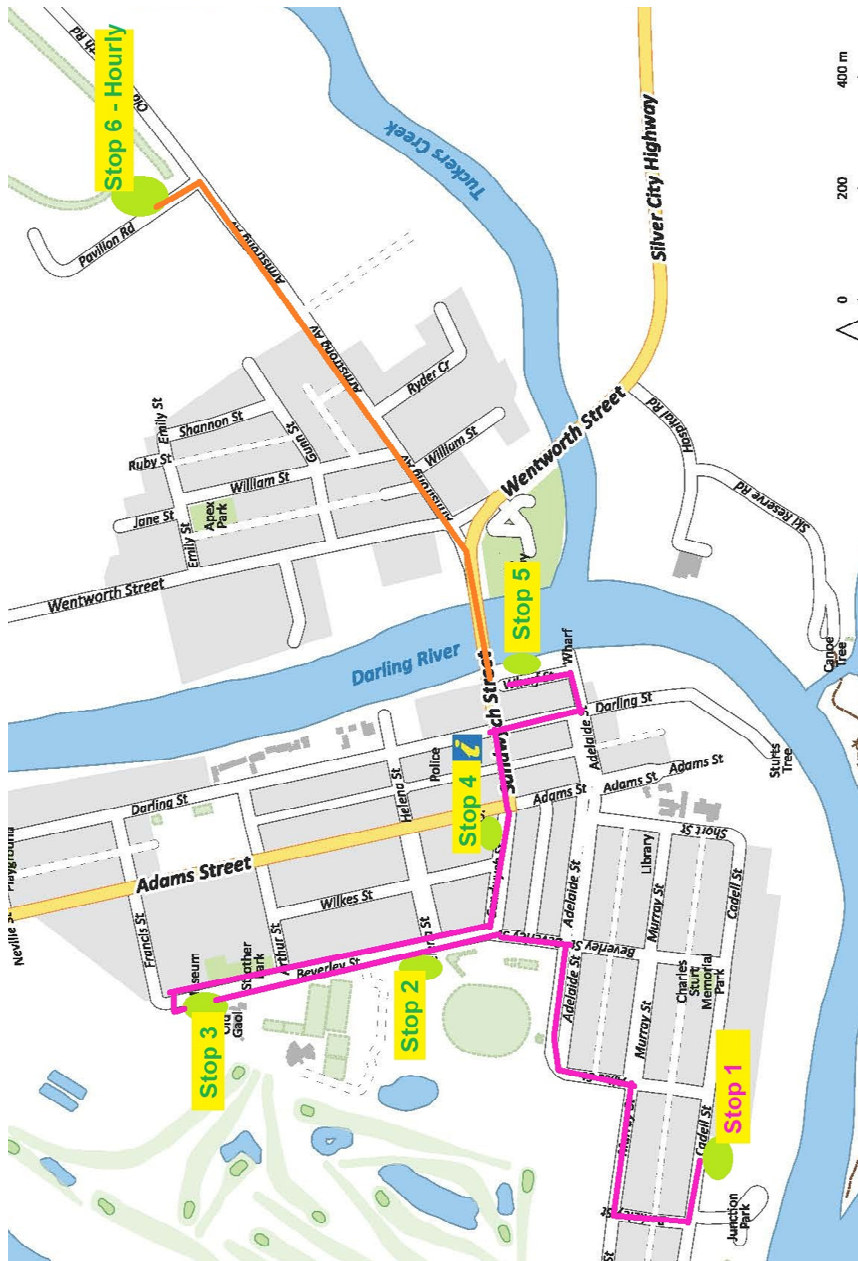

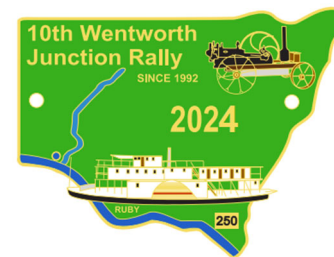

## Greetings from President of the Rivers & Riverboat Historical Preservation Society Inc



The Rivers & Riverboat Historical & Preservation Society Inc (Riverboat Society) and the Vintage Machinery Society of Sunraysia inc have put on the Junction Rally at the Junction of the Murray & Darling Rivers since 1992.

As President of the Riverboat Society I am pleased to welcome you to the 2024 Junction Rally.

The Riverboat Society is based in Mildura is a group of people interested in Riverboats and the history of the inland rivers. If you are interested in playing around with boats or just interested in river history we would welcome you into our group.

We have 3 trailerable boats being 1. The “Willaba”, a lifeboat that ended its life transporting sheep in the Darling River during the 1956 flood. 2. PS “Minimus” a small steamer built by Geoff & Dot Walker from Geelong who donated it to the Riverboat Society. 3. The GD Walker is an ex SES rescue punt converted for overnight camping also donated by Geoff & Dot Walker. The main project by the Riverboat Society is the conversion of the AII barge to a paddlewheeler. Built in 1911 at Echuca for the redgum trade was lying derelict in Mildura. The Riverboat Society restored it as a barge twice. It has laid at Bruce’s Bend until recently when it was moved to Baldwins Boat yard to do the conversion.

We would like to thank the Baldwin family for their generosity in removing the AII from the river and allowing us to work in their shipyard , doing the conversion.

Our meetings are on the 1st Tuesday of the month held at Irymple Hotel. We hope you enjoy the Rally and thank you for your attendance.

I am delighted to invite you to the 10<sup>th</sup> Wentworth Junction Rally on Saturday 6 July from 10am to 4pm and Sunday 7 July from 10am to 3pm at Junction Park, Cadell Street, Wentworth.

This historic event, established in 1992, returns after cancellations in 2020 and 2023 due to COVID-19 and flooding. The Rally offers daily cruises, vintage machinery exhibits, and a spectacular display of paddleboats lining the riverbank. The program includes a parade of boats, markets, community food stalls, free children's entertainment, a rope throwing competition, continuous engine and machinery demonstrations, and a weather-permitting flyover. This unique location provides a stunning backdrop for a weekend of festivities and exploration.

A shuttle bus service will be circling throughout the township of Wentworth for the Rally weekend; giving opportunity to visit local businesses, museums, and the historic Wentworth Gaol offering a glimpse into the community's past and present. Enjoy unique shopping, cosy cafes, classic outback pubs and the historic Port of Wentworth.

While enjoying the Rally weekend, explore the rich cultural and natural attractions of Wentworth Shire. Delve into the history of the township named in 1859. Many historic buildings are still in operation today; Wentworth Court house built in 1880 and the first church built on the banks of the Darling River, St John the Evangelist. Lock 10 & Weir are situated 830kms from the Murray Mouth and completed in 1929 which have played significant roles in our waterways. Nature enthusiasts can marvel at Perry Sandhills, the River Redgum God Tree, and the Australian Inland Botanic Gardens at Mourquong. Explore local artefacts, art, and the rich history of the traditional landowners at the Barkindji Wiimpatya Murra Centre. Discover golf clubs, bowling greens, boutique wineries and fresh produce in our Wentworth Shire.

I look forward to seeing you at the Wentworth Junction Rally.
